Powered by friendship, the Light from Light mission expanded significantly last year. Americans and proven Haitian leaders are feeding the flame of progress in communities where suffering, lack and hunger have prevailed too long.

Together we are strengthening the foundations of progress, **empowering Haitians** to build and sustain long-lasting change.

Building community cornerstones


25,000+ patient consultations, at Lespwa Timoun and mobile clinics, addressed medical issues like cholera, parasites and chronic disease, plus provided well services like OB/GYN care and vaccinations.

Road construction, completed by joint Haitian-American teams, improved access to medical and economic resources for residents of the remote Crochu mountain area.

Community health classes educated Haitian families on sanitation, disease prevention and the importance of breastfeeding.

3 in 5 Haitians live on less than US\$2/day.

1 in 4 children in rural areas do not attend school.



We promote and protect the well-being of children through nutrition and child sponsorship programs.



Nurturing children

4,795 newborns and children received life-sustaining care through an intensive nutrition program, helping families defy Haiti's high child mortality rate.

Our new Child Sponsorship Program ensures an education, weekday lunches and medical care for 120 children grades K-9 for just over \$1 per day.

A new Nutrition Wing at the Lespwa Timoun clinic is being planned to house the further expansion of these programs and provide care to children with extreme malnutrition.

1 in 5 Haitian children are malnourished.

Haitians leaders lack access to funding, resources and best practices.



Empowering local leaders

24 birthing attendants, or midwives, receive ongoing medical training. Last year, they provided pre/postnatal care to 103 mothers and delivered 159 babies in the rural Crochu area.

Community health workers serve their local communities, providing block-by-block and village-by-village outreach to those in need of care and education.

The Lespwa Timoun health clinic, located in Croix des Bouquets and led by Carmel Valdema, R.N., continues to expand its reach and sustainability through strategic and operational partnership with Light from Light.
